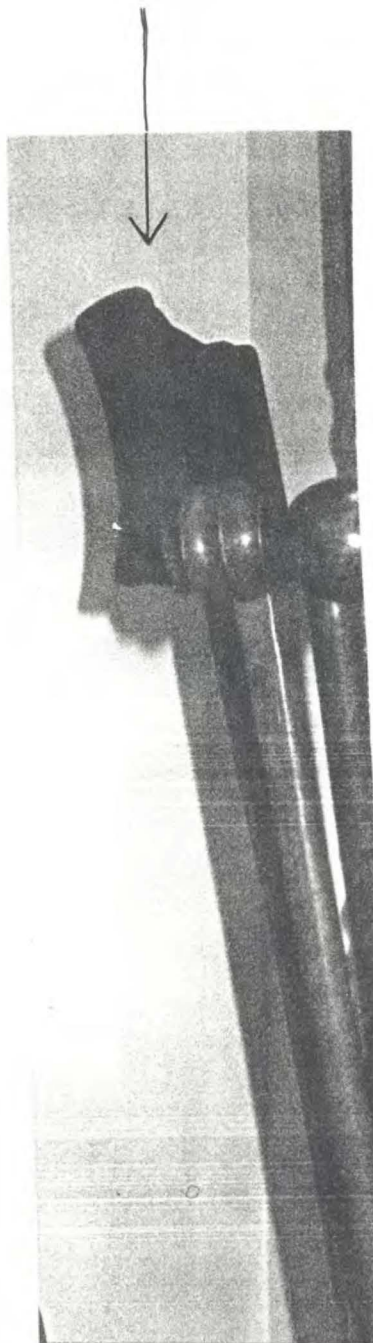

33A. STAFF/HEADREST

This combined staff/headrest would complement and extend the group of three similar objects in the Brenthurst Collection. Each one, however, is different in terms of style and motifs. The Horstmann example differs from the other three in that the headrest is at the end of the staff, rather than being placed three quarters the way on its shaft. The addition of this staff/headrest will provide an interesting and comprehensive group of a fairly unusual type of form.

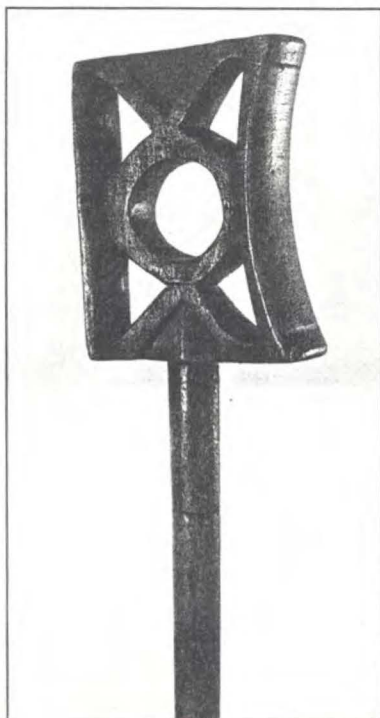
