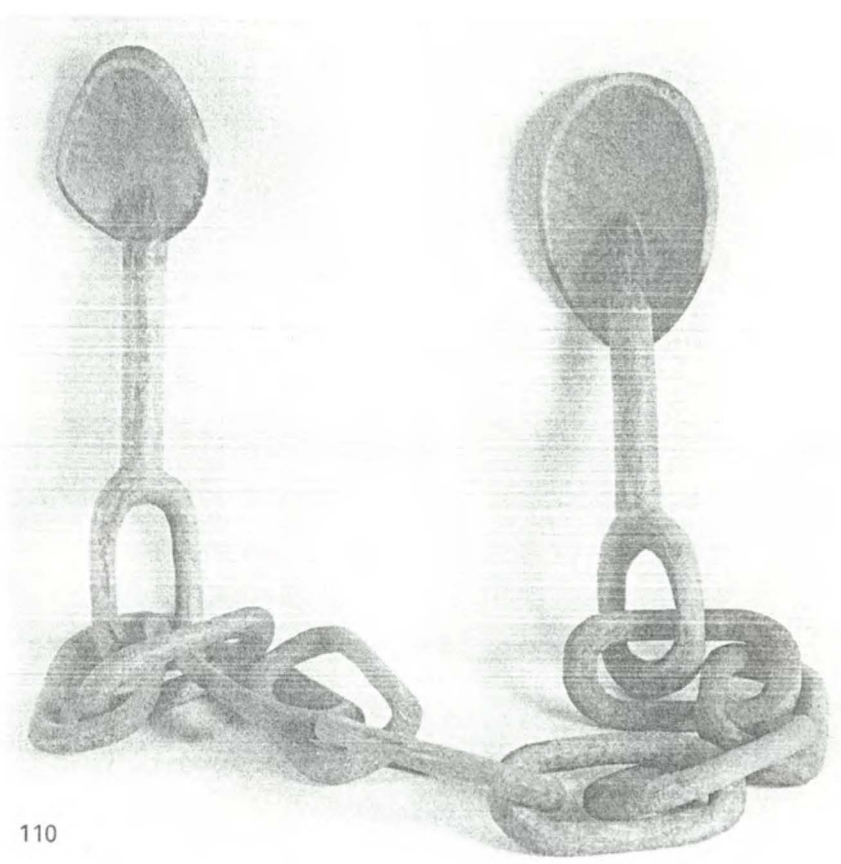

This is a superb and rare example of a Zulu spoon. It does not duplicate spoons in the Brenthurst Collection, although the twisted form relates to a pair of apparently commercially produced spoons. The Horsmann example is much older and is of greater quality, while providing an important historical comparison with the later examples.



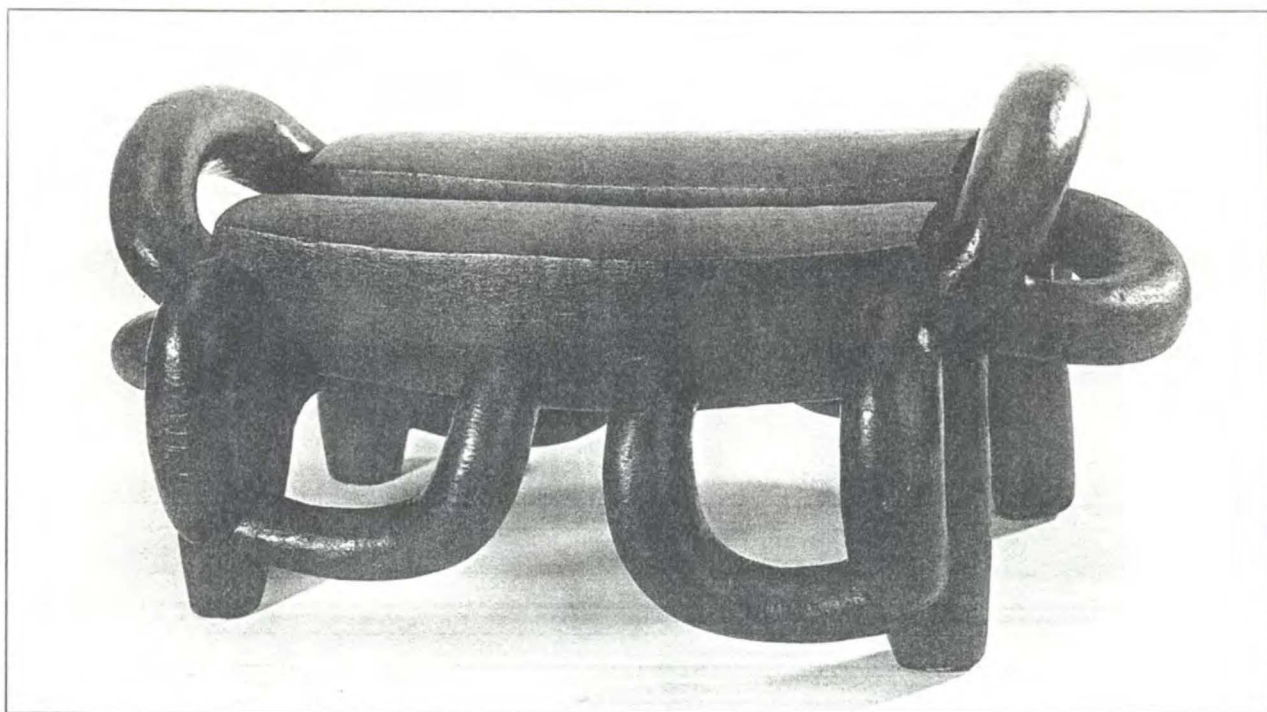

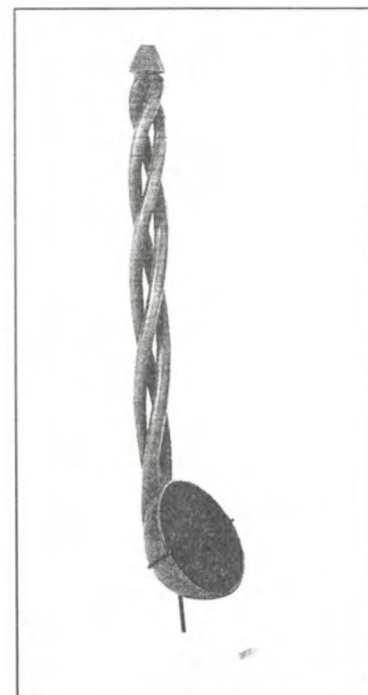
