The natives were without leaders in the last rebellion. That is a lesson they have learnt and will know how to provide against next time. Necessity provides the man - an invariable rule. Had they had a man who organized their forces, the result would have been different. Moreover, they differed from the Zulus of 1879 in that they were not in a state of organization.
